Footpaths

General Notes

The Scottish Mountaineering Trust is from time to time able to provide financial assistance in connection with footpath repairs and related projects in the mountainous regions of Scotland. All applications are considered on their individual merits but Trustees will generally apply the following rules.

Grants are normally made subject to all other project funding being in place and that a definite time for the commencement of the project has been agreed. Funds are not provided unduly in advance and the project must not vary from that outlined in the application. Grants are provided principally to assist with the cost of labour and materials - the Trust will not assist in the purchase of capital equipment for organisations or footpath improvement companies.

It is a requirement of the Trust maintaining its charitable status that any application must also have a declared and patent educational or scientific purpose - the increase in mountain safety engendered by footpath improvement is deemed by Trustees to fall within the definition.

Where a grant is made, the Trust requests acknowledgement of its support in any publicly printed material. The Trust reserves the right to attach such conditions to any grant as may be deemed appropriate. All grants relating to footpath projects will lapse if not taken up within a period of two years.

The Trust does not involve itself in project management and does not accept liability for any claims resulting from the project.

Where a project is cancelled any monies advanced by the Trust must be refunded without undue delay.
